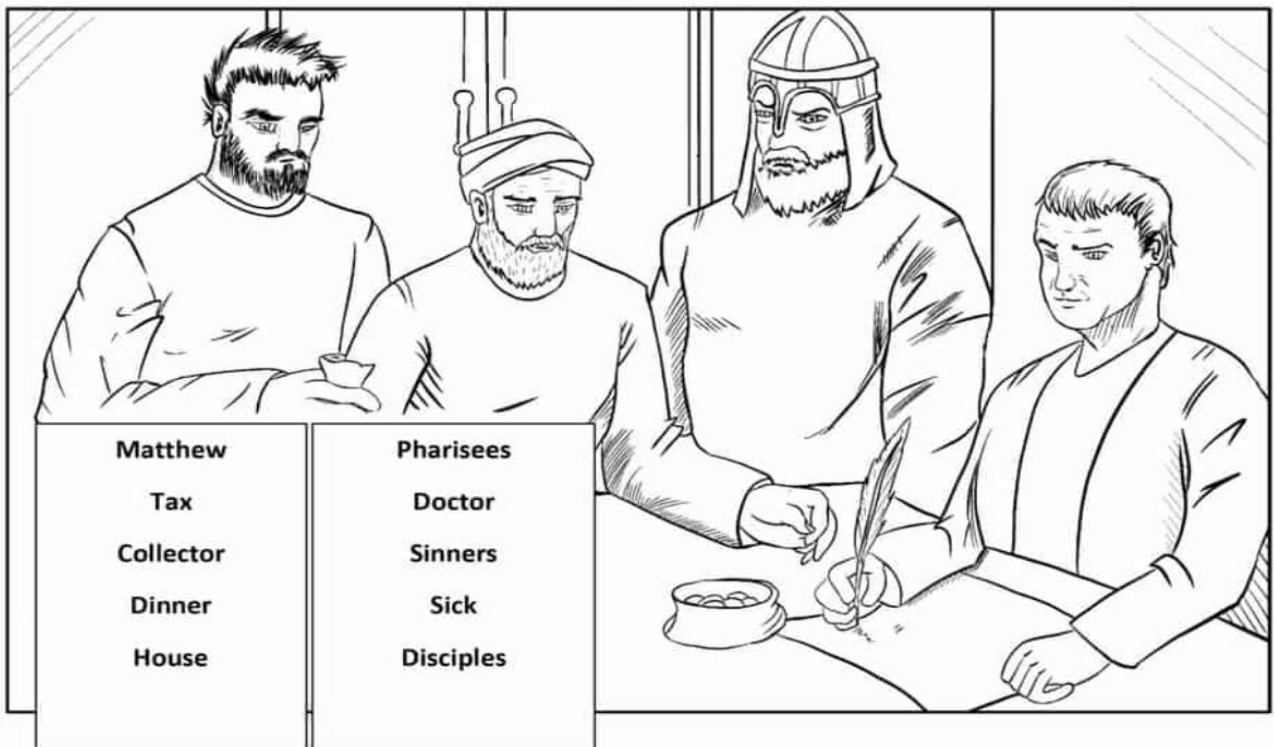


As Jesus went on from there, He saw a man named Matthew sitting at the Tax Collectors booth.

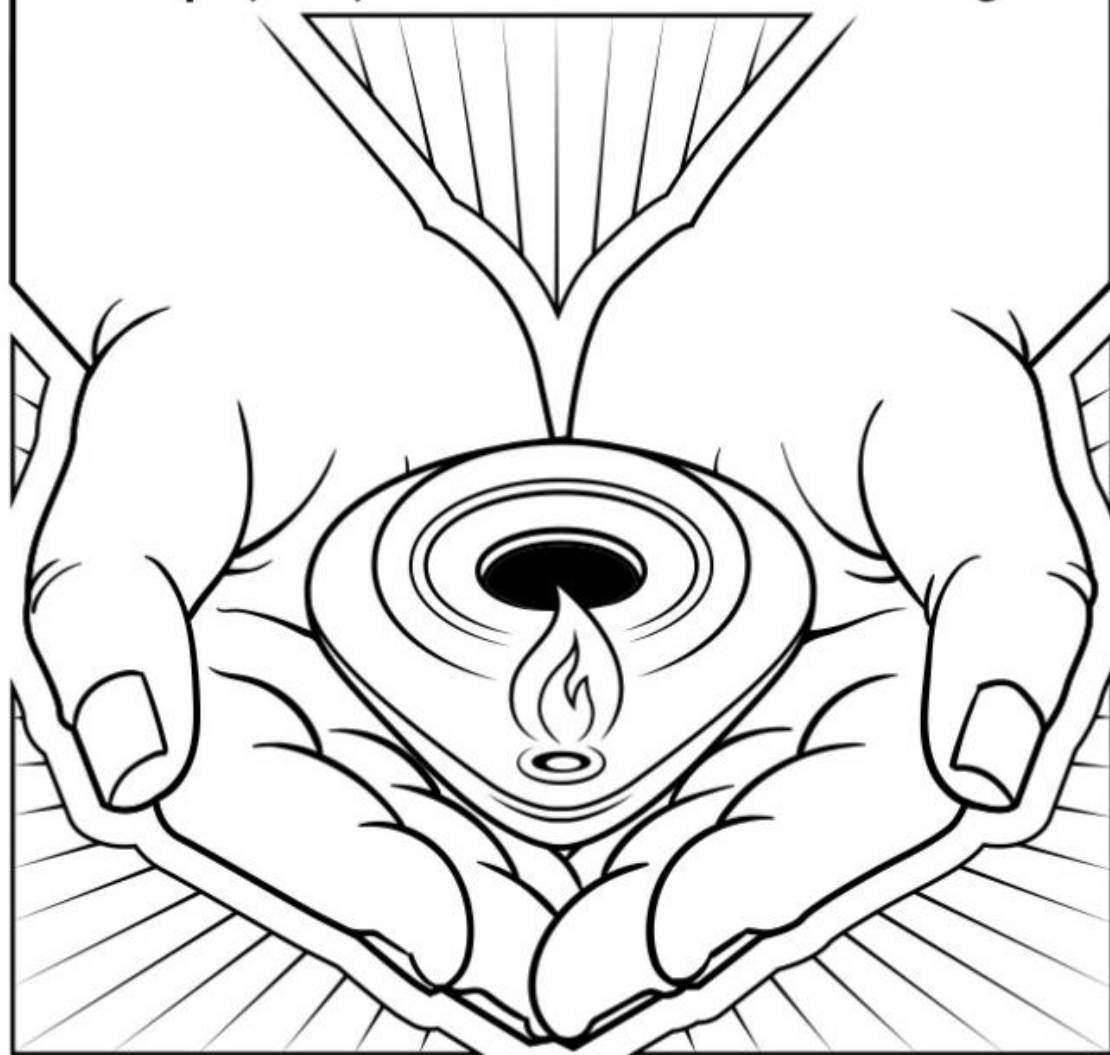
